The ECHO Board is back with some news and updates from the Histio Community.

1. Obituary: Ron Jaffe, M.D.

It is with deep grief to inform you that the International Histio Community has lost Ron Jaffe, a former member of the pathology panel of the Histiocyte Society, a brilliant pediatric pathologist, a dedicated expert in the pathology of the histiocytic disorders, a compassionate mentor, and friend.

Born in Johannesburg, South Africa, in June of 1943, Ron graduated from the University of Witwatersrand with an M.B. B.Ch. in 1969. He went on to complete residencies in Pathology at Sheba Medical Center (Tel Hashomer, Israel) and Children's Hospital (Boston, MA), 1971-75 and 1975-76, respectively, followed by a fellowship at the Mallory Institute of Pathology (Boston, MA) from 1976-77.



Ron held a deep and unwavering passion for pediatric pathology, particularly for histiocytic disorders, throughout five decades of his life. He served as a referent pathologist for all International LCH Clinical Trials of the Histiocyte Society, as well as for the International Registry on Rare Histiocytic Disorders. Beyond his immense contributions to the field, he will be remembered as a generous mentor, a world-renowned scientist, and a quiet yet wickedly funny colleague.

He will be greatly missed by all of us who had the privilege of knowing him.

2. Toward a prospective trial for the most severe LCH disease form

I am happy to share that we have held a fruitful meeting for the LCH-IV PIs of the European countries in Vienna, dedicated to the preparation of a prospective trial for HR-MS-LCH. We have agreed on the study design and treatment backbone combining inhibitors and chemotherapy, aiming for a definitive cure for the affected kids. We have come to agreements regarding the primary and secondary endpoints of the study and response evaluation. An action plan for protocol finalization and clarification of organizational and regulatory issues has been worked out. We will keep you posted.

3. Plans for meetings in person in 2023
